- i) Name of Examination Centre and Date of Examination & Timings shall be mentioned in the E-Admit Card. The E-Admit Cards will be available 07 days before the exam date.
- ii) Detailed Instructions regarding Online Examination and downloading of admit cards will be given shortly on the official website of the University.
- iii) Candidates may also be informed on their registered mobile no. as well. But in case a candidate does not get any information on his/her registered mobile no. due to any reason, then it would not give any right to the candidate for extension of downloading e-admit card or re-examination.

iv) Candidate must go through all the instructions and guidelines regarding eligibility, qualifications, reservations policies etc.as mentioned in the Advertisement No.AUD/01/HR/2021 dated 11.04.2021 and No.AUD/02/HR/2022 dated 29.01.2022, before appearing in the examination. They must ensure that they fulfill their eligibility as on the closing date of online application.

As regards to the reservation policies, the same will be available to the SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwD candidates in accordance with the extant Instructions/Orders/Circulars issued from time to time by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi/DOP&T, Govt. of India.

It is further clarified that Other Backward Classes(OBCs) for the purpose of employment under the University shall be the Castes, as notified by the Central Government in the Central List for Delhi and Castes defined as OBCs by the OBC Commission of Delhi and notified by the Government of NCT of Delhi from time to time. Further, as per the guidelines issued by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi vide Notification No.F.19(10)/2001/S-III/Pt.File/2278-2285 dated 27.07.2007, it is clarified that the Central list for OBCs qua Delhi and castes defined as OBCs by OBC Commission and accepted so by the Government will be extended the benefit of reservation in Delhi. The reservation policies pertaining to the OBC reservation shall be applicable as per the guidelines issued by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi from time to time (Govt of NCT of Delhi Notification No.F.19(10)/2001/S-III/Pt.File/2278-2285 dated 27.07.2007. No.19(01)/2012/S.IV/1241-1258 dated 28.7.2016 and No.F.19(02)/2011/S.IV/Vol.I/856 dated 31.05.2021).

- The E-Admit Cards will be generated purely on the basis of data submitted by the V) candidates at the time of online application. The details of eligibility such as essential qualifications, reservation etc. as mentioned in the application forms will be verified with the original documents at the time of document verification/skill test. Hence, their candidature will remain provisional till the veracity of the concerned document is verified. Candidates are cautioned that they will be debarred from the examination conducted by the University in case they fraudulently claim SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwD/ESM status or avail benefit.
- vi) Mere generation of the Admit Card and appearing in the examination shall not confer any right of appointment to any candidate.
