ABOUT US

SES is envisioned to evolve as a community of professionals and scholars endeavouring to understand education in its historical and contemporary contexts through engaged scholarship and practice. The School aims to bridge the gap between the theory and practice of education in its multiple locations-in that, it attempts to foster greater convergence between the study of education as a social phenomenon and the preparation of professional educators. AUD is now launching four years Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP), also called BABEd programmes aim to bring together multidisciplinary undergraduate education and professional preparation of schoolteachers. The programmes envision to provide excellent quality pre-service teacher education that addresses the longstanding issue of insufficient focus on disciplinary knowledge and lack of its integration with professional knowledge in teacher preparation in India.



ABOUT INTEGRATED TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMME (ITEP)

The ITEP or BABEd programmes at SES will prepare schoolteachers for two school stages, preparatory (III to V) and secondary (IX to XII), based on the curricular structure proposed by the National Education Policy 2020 (5+3+3+4). As dual major degrees, the programmes will offer the students a holistic undergraduate education equivalent to an undergraduate degree in selected areas of social sciences and humanities relevant for school teaching, as well as provide them the minimum qualification for school teaching at preparatory and secondary stages.

By 2030 these programmes will be the essential degree qualifications for becoming school teachers as per the new school curriculum structure recommended by NEP 2020, i.e., 5+3+3+4. The B.A.B.Ed programmes will provide dual-major multidisciplinary undergraduate education blended with professional teacher preparation for future teachers. After completion of the programme, the students will be eligible to become school teachers and also take up further studies at par with other undergraduate programmes. The students will be taught by expert faculty members from different areas of study at the University and will be able to take elective courses from other programmes based on their interests.
