APPOINTMENT OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR ON CONTRACT

Applications are invited from the eligible candidates suitable for appointment against one vacant post of UR category as Assistant Professor purely on contract basis for School of Vocational Studies (SVS) in Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi for the BVoc / MVoc programmes such as (BVoc. Tourism & Hospitality and MVoc. Tourism & Hospitality Management). The appointment will be made initially for a period of six months which is likely to be continued for an another session as per the requirement OR till the post is filled on regular basis, whichever is earlier. The persons so selected shall have to join immediately. The candidates will be engaged for teaching assignments. The incumbent should be passionate for teaching, agile in his/her approach, enjoy student interaction, networking with the industry partners and familiar with the emerging trend related to vocational education and skill development. The number of vacancies at present are as below:

(A) Eligibility Conditions: Details of qualifications and experience etc., for the posts shall be as per the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018 and also as per other relevant Rules and Regulations for the said post :-

Tourism & Hospitality Management	A. i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in the subject area of Tourism & Hospitality for the posts from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university. ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of

	M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET: Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions :- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode; b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners; c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted; d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal; e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any other similar agency. The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned. Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET. OR B. The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai). Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018, for Universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.
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A. Honorarium:

The candidates appointed on contract basis will be paid fixed emoluments not less than the monthly gross salary of regularly appointed Assistant Professor as per AUD/ GNCTD/ UGC norms.

If the services of any candidate are not found satisfactory, his/ her services may be terminated forthwith without assigning any reason to him/ her.

Other Instructions:

1. Benefit of reservation for various categories i.e. SC/ ST/ OBC candidates shall be given as per the policy of Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

2. Application forms have to be filled mandatorily in online mode only as available on the website of the University within the prescribed time limit as indicated in the advertisement.
3. The recruitment shall be made in accordance with the “UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and also as per other relevant rules as applicable.
4. The prescribed essential qualifications are the minimum and the mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for the interview. Where the number of applications received in response to this advertisement is large and it is not feasible or convenient to interview all the candidates, the University at its discretion, may restrict the number of candidates to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualifications / experience higher than the minimum prescribed for the post. The University, however, prefers candidate possessing higher qualifications and experience.
5. The dates of interviews will be notified on the University website only and the same will be communicated through email (as provided in the application form) to the shortlisted candidates. Any change of correspondence address/ email/ phone from the one given in the application form should at once be communicated to the University.
6. Candidates are advised to visit the University website at regular intervals for the updates.
7. The process of selection may be by a presentation/seminar/interview or a combination thereof.
8. The University shall process the applications entirely on the basis of information/ documents submitted by the candidates. In case the information/documents are found to be false/ incorrect by way of omission or commission, the responsibility and liability shall lie solely with the candidate.
9. Applicants who have been awarded Ph.D. from foreign Universities should enclose “Equivalence Certificate” issued by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, without which their candidature will not be considered and application will summarily be rejected.
10. The assessment shall be based on evidence produced by the applicant such as: copy of publications, project sanction letter, utilization and completion certificates issued by the University and acknowledgements for patent filing and approval letters, students’ Ph.D. award letter etc.
11. Before applying for a post, applicants are advised to go through the relevant UGC Regulation, 2018 as well as contents of the advertisement carefully and satisfy themselves about their eligibility. No enquiry in this regard will be entertained.
12. Relaxations as per UGC Regulations, 2018 on the Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018 for Universities:-
 - i) A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor’s as well as at the Master’s level for the candidates belonging to Schedules Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes(OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of the eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualification marks without any grace mark procedure.
13. All correspondence from the University including interview letter, if any, shall be sent only at the e-mail address provided by the applicant in the online application form. The applicants are advised to check the website of the University regularly for updates. No separate communication by post shall be made.
14. Any addendum/ corrigendum, if any, shall be posted on our university website <http://aud.ac.in/careers> only.
15. Canvassing in any form will be treated as a disqualification.
16. Incomplete applications in any respect shall be summarily rejected.

17. The University reserves the right to revise/reschedule/cancel/suspend/withdraw the recruitment process in part or full without assigning any reason. The decision of the University shall be final and no appeal in this regard shall be entertained.
18. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after issuing an appointment letter, the University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the applicant in this regard.
19. If the service of any candidate is not found satisfactory, his/ her services may be terminated forthwith without assigning any reason to him/ her.
20. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final.
21. In case of any dispute, any suite or legal proceedings against the University, the territorial jurisdiction shall be the High Court of Delhi.
22. Recruitment to the Contractual posts of Assistant Professor in the University shall be made on the recommendations of the duly constituted Selection Committees. The recruitment shall be made in accordance with the “UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018” and Regulations of other regulatory bodies wherever applicable and also as per the norms of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University Delhi.
23. In accordance with the UGC Regulations, 2018 as amended from time to time along with Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University Delhi, Acts, Statutes and Ordinances, including amendments made thereafter, applicants applying for the post of Assistant Professor and seeking exemption of NET requirement must submit a certificate in the prescribed format as per **Annexure-I & II (as applicable)** from the concerned University to the effect that their Ph.D. degree is in compliance with relevant UGC Regulations for award of Ph.D. degree.
24. Incomplete application or application without documents or any application with any kind of discrepancy shall be rejected straightly without any assigning any reason.
