Empowering Women across all Sectors

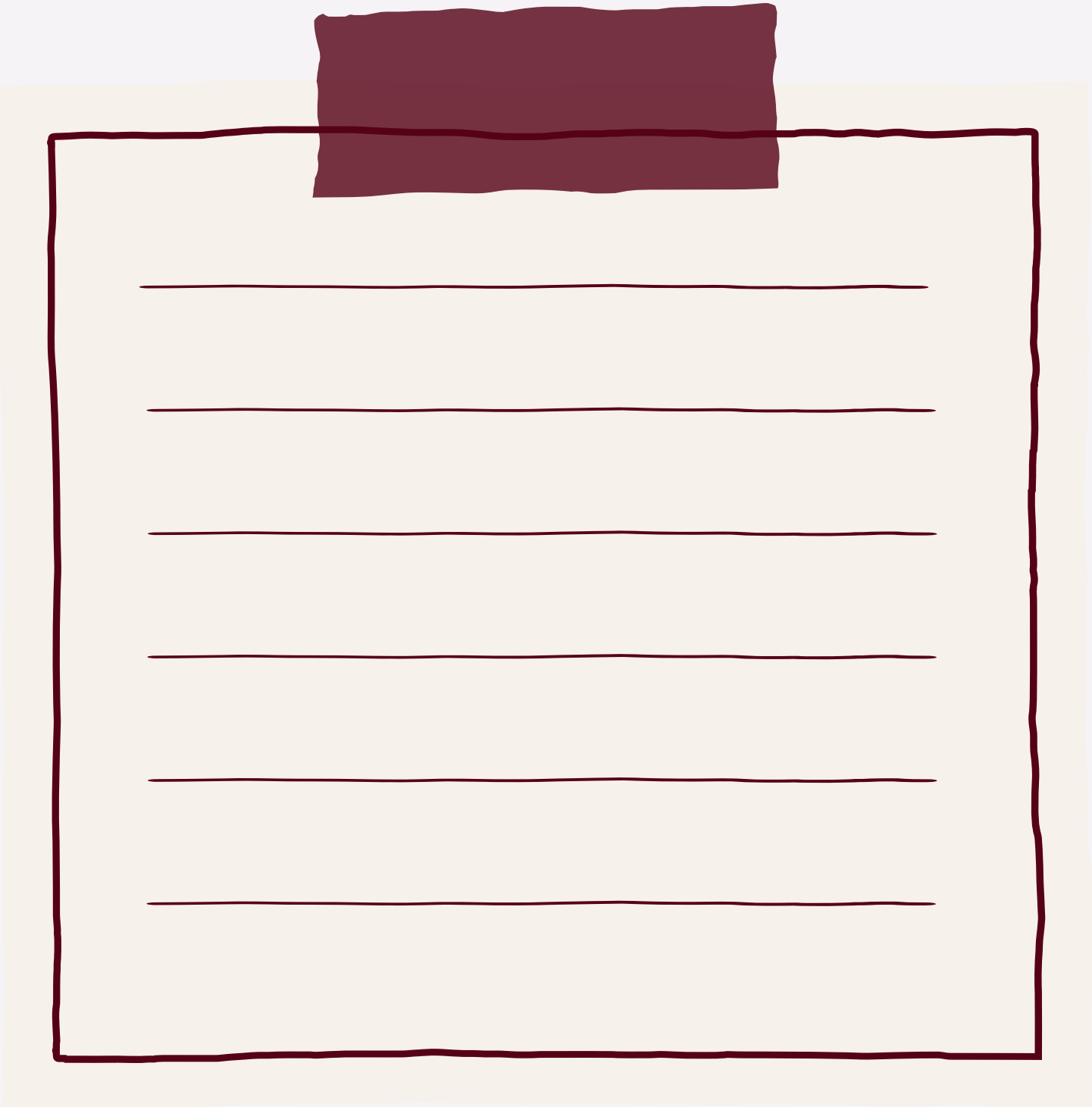

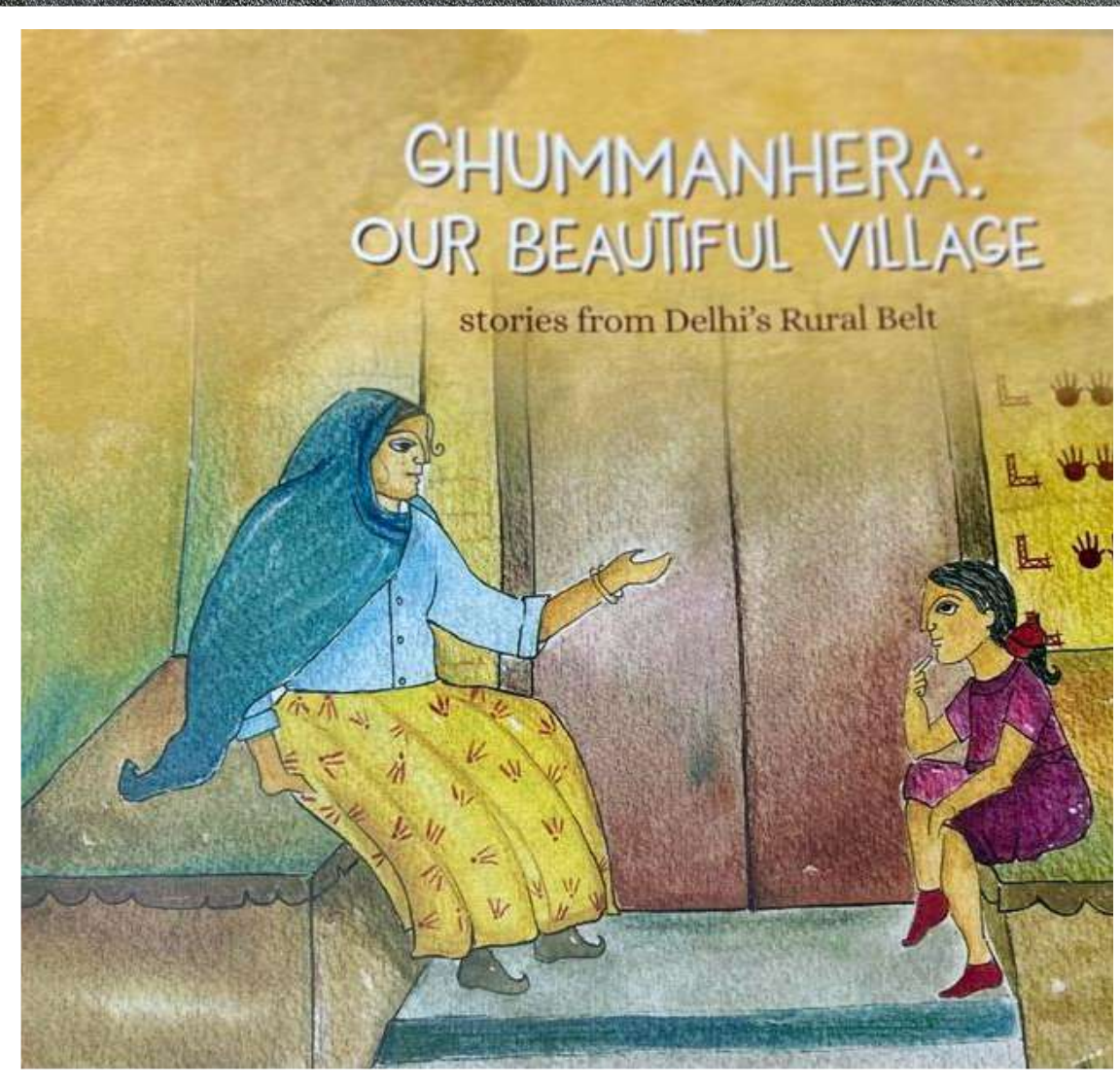
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Percentage of women students who received degrees at the 2023 Convocation were 58% in UG and PG combined, 77% in MPhil and 72% in PhD Programmes. There is equal representation of women and men in faculty. University has conducted outreach initiatives with women in its adopted villages, has felicitated women taxi drivers of Delhi. It has distributed certificates to its women security guards and sanitation workers for their contribution to the University.

Advancements

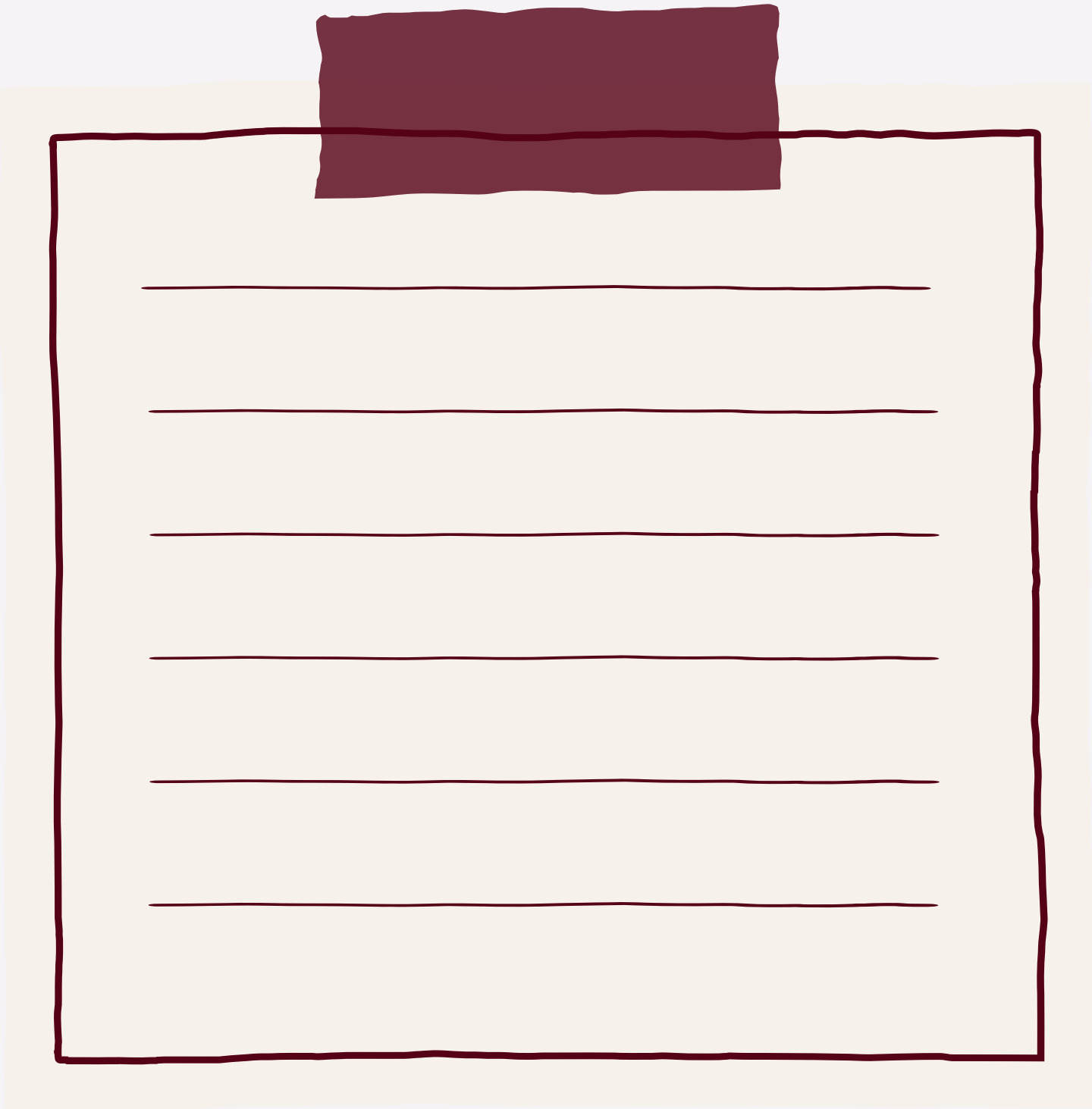
