AUD Student Union Elections 2025-26 Code of Conduct*

13th February, 2025

This Code of Conduct automatically comes into force after the AUD Student Union Elections 2025-26 schedules are released.

- 1. The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate and per phase shall be Rs. 2500/-each
- 2. Each candidate shall, within two weeks of the declaration of the result, submit complete and audited accounts to the Election Committee. The election of the candidate will be nullified in the event of noncompliance with any of the above rules/quidelines or in the event of any excessive expenditure.
- 3. No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
- 4. It is mandatory for all Councillor Candidates to attend and participate in their respective debate(s) at phase I and II. No cross questioning and personal remarks will be entertained, in violation of which his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- 5. Candidates shall be prohibited from indulging or abetting all activities which are considered to be 'corrupt practices' and offences, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters; canvassing or the use of propaganda within 100 meters of polling centres, holding public meetings, during the period of 24 hours ending with the hour fixed for the close of the poll.
- 6. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has made the provisions contained in Section 153A and Chapter IX-A "Offences relating to election" of IPC applicable to Students election. Objectionable incidents, therefore, must be reported to the Election Committee, which shall be subsequently forwarded to the Police if deemed necessary, within 12 hours after the alleged commission of offence, to register cases under relevant Sections of IPC.
- 7. No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlet, or any other printed material for the purpose of canvassing. Candidates may only utilize handmade posters for the purpose of canvassing, in accordance to NGT order (OA No. 402/2015 dated July 18, 2016)
- (a) The limit for posters for each candidate for Phase-1** is3. (A3 size paper, maximum)

(b) The limit for posters for each candidate for Phase-2** is6. (A3 size paper, maximum)

- (c) The posters are allowed to be pasted only on the notice boards in the campus.
- 8. All the candidates are allowed to go for online campaigning within the allotted time only. However, the candidate should take care of all the mandates and Code of Conduct mentioned by the Election Committee, AUD.
- 9. The use of loudspeaker, vehicle and animals for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited.
- 10. All candidates are expected to abide by the guidelines set by the Election Committee of the University. The violation of Guidelines and Code of Conduct could lead to the cancellation of candidature, or their elected post, as the case may be.. The university authorities may also take appropriate disciplinary action against such a violator.
