Rani Lakshmi Bai was named Manikarnika by her parents. She learnt about horsemanship, archery and excelled in sword-fighting. In the first war of Independence against the British in 1857, raising a volunteer army of 14000 men and women, the Queen single-handedly set up defense against the British forces. At one point she was captured, but daringly jumped off the fort and escaped. She reflected in herself a strong symbol of resistance to the imperial rule for indian nationalists. Lakshmibai, became a legend, a figure of inspiration to the Nationalist Struggle later on. Our school textbooks are incomplete without the mention of the brave Queen; from folklore, to Amar-Chitra Katha comics, poetry, and TV serials, she has continued to inspire generations.

Savitri Bai Phule

Savitri Bai Phule She became the first female teacher in India (1848) and opened a school for girls with her husband, Jyotirao Phule. She went on to establish a shelter (1864) for destitute women and played a crucial role in grooming Jyotirao Phule's pioneering institution, Satyashodhak Samaj, (1873) that fought for equality of all classes. The Samaj primarily aimed at eliminating discrimination. She published Kavya Phule (Poetry's Blossoms, 1854) and Bavan Kashi Subodh Ratnakar (The Ocean of Pure Gems, 1892) and the famous poem (Go, Get Education). Her life and work is evidence to social reform and women's emancipation in India.

Kalpana Chawla

Kalpana Chawla was an Indian born American astronaut and a famous aerospace engineer who was the first woman of Indian origin to contribute to eminent space research projects. Her work focused on understanding how air flows around an aircraft during flight and incorporating computers into the work. She was chosen to be a part of the famous Space Shuttle Columbia in 1997 where she was entrusted with the responsibility of the mission specialist and robotic arm operator. She was a part of the seven crew members who passed away in the infamous Space Shuttle Columbia disaster in the year of 2003. It was the same crew who had done more than 80 experiments in the field of earth, space science and advanced technology development on astronaut safety. In October 2020, a commercial cargo spacecraft named after Chawla launched to the International Space Station. She was awarded famous Congressional Space medal of Honour posthumously.

Sunita Williams

Sunita Williams was selected as an astronaut by NASA in 1998 and is a veteran of two space missions, an US navy officer with Indian roots. Williams worked in Moscow with the Russian Space Agency on the Russian contribution to the space station and also worked with the Robotics branch. With 50 hours and 40 minutes, Williams once again held the record for total cumulative spacewalk time by a female astronaut. Williams, who has spent a total of 322 days in space on two missions, now ranks sixth on the all-time U.S. endurance list, and second all-time for a female astronaut. She has received various awards like Navy Commendation Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, Medal for Merit in Space Exploration, Govt. of Russia and Padma Bhushan (2008).

When she returned to the court after her maternity break, she retained the same zest for the sport. She has also been awarded Arjuna Award (2004), Padma Shri in (2006), Padma Bhushan (2016), and for her outstanding contribution to the field of tennis.

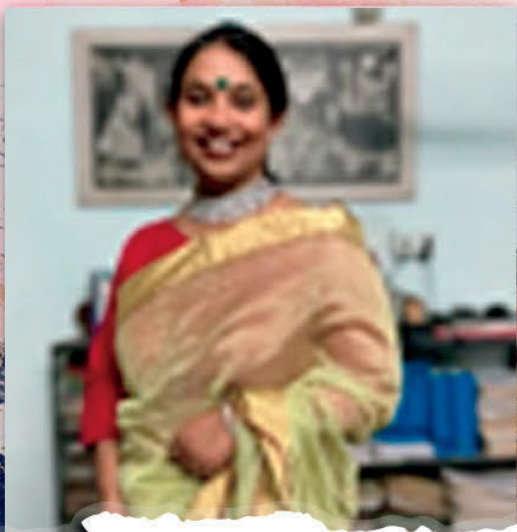
