The eligibility for admission to M.A. Clinical Psychology will be "B.A. Psychology of four years duration with practical orientation/research in clinical psychology in the last year of graduation". The institutions/ universities offering the 3 years UG program under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) may offer bridge courses, as per public notice issued by UGC on 1-3-2024 (copy attached).
