### **Programme Mapping for Under Graduate Programmes of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi for CUET (UG) 2026**

Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi shall be admitting students to various Undergraduate programmes offered under different Schools of Studies for the Academic Year 2026–27 based on the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) examination conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).

All candidates desirous of seeking admission to Undergraduate programmes at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi are required to **register and appear in CUET (UG)–2026** through the official NTA website <https://cuet.nta.nic.in>, in accordance with the eligibility criteria and programme-wise requirements prescribed by the University. Subsequently candidates shall also have to apply to the University, the details for which will be announced on the University website in due course.

Candidates must also note that the list of programs below is indicative. The University reserves the right to not offer admission in any of the programs, offer admissions in programs not in the list, or offer admissions through other modalities to be announced.
