

Field Trip to Bhopal

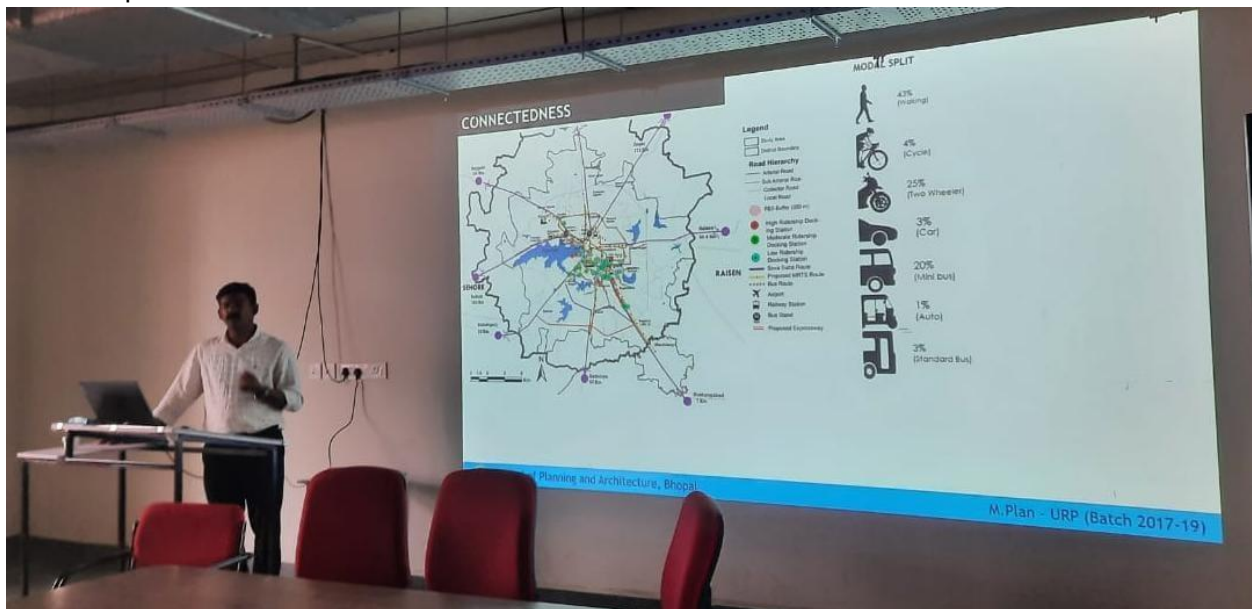

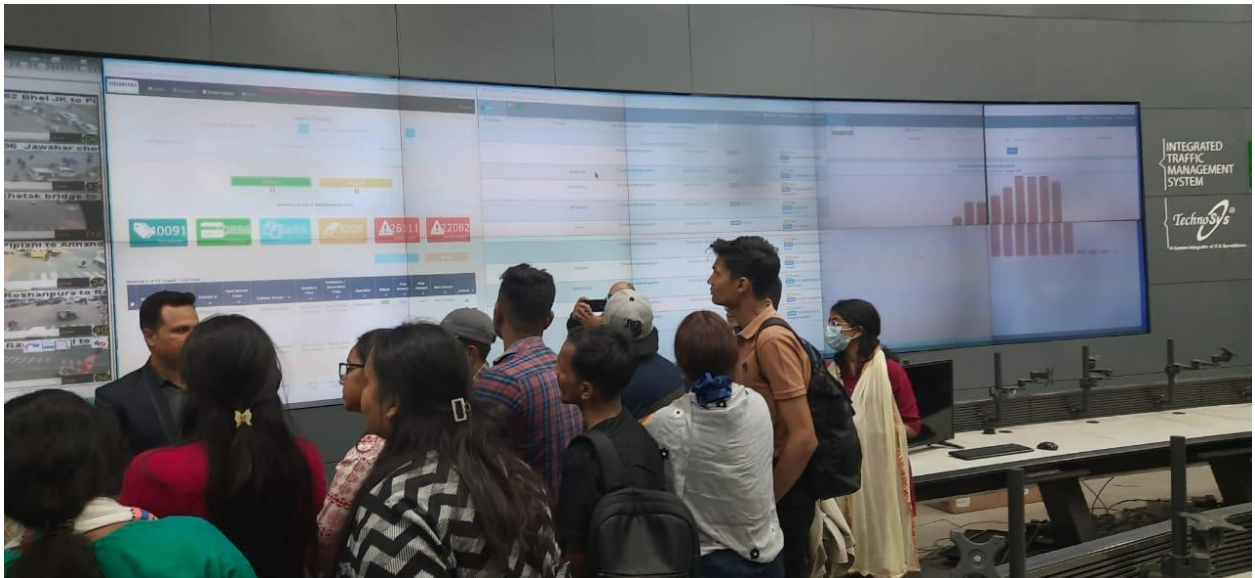
