The two-day workshop titled “Personal Finance and Investment Management” was organised on 19th and 20th February 2026 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Room No. 404, KP Campus by the School of Vocational Studies, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University Delhi in collaboration with the National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM). The workshop aimed to enhance students’ financial literacy, familiarise them with the ecosystem of capital markets, and equip them with the knowledge and skills required for responsible investing and for exploring career opportunities in the financial services sector. The programme was meant for final-year undergraduate and postgraduate students, and a total of 57 participants from B.Voc. Accounting and Finance, B.Voc. Retail Management and M.Voc. programmes attended the sessions. The workshop was coordinated by Dr. Rekha Gulia and Dr. Neelu Verma under the guidance of the Dean (SVS), Dr. Renu Ghosh.



The sessions were conducted by Dr. Mukul Jain, Professor of Practice at J.K. Business School, an empanelled training faculty with SEBI and NISM. Over the two days, the resource person covered important areas such as financial goal setting, the power of compounding, various investment avenues, primary and secondary markets, mutual funds, asset allocation, KYC procedures, investor rights, protection against fraudulent schemes and career prospects in the securities market. The sessions were highly interactive and included practical activities such as analysis of company prospectuses and understanding stock selection using fundamental parameters. Real-life examples and references to recent financial developments helped in simplifying complex concepts and keeping the students actively engaged.



The workshop witnessed sincere participation and interest from the students throughout both days. It helped bridge the gap between theoretical learning and practical application and enabled students to develop a structured approach towards personal financial planning and investment decisions. The key outcomes included greater awareness about financial markets, improved confidence in understanding investment products and better clarity regarding professional avenues in the capital markets domain. The feedback received from the participants was very positive, with students appreciating the practical orientation of the sessions, the clarity of explanation and the relevance of the content to their academic learning and future careers. Overall, the workshop proved to be a meaningful and enriching learning experience and successfully met its intended objectives.
