



Admissions under Co-Curricular Activity (CCA) Category

Candidates who have special talent and achievements in the areas of Sports, Theatre, Dance, Music, Fine Arts, Debating and Creative Writing can apply under the CCA category for admission to any programme of AUD, except in the School of Culture & Creative Expressions and the School of Business, Public Policy & Social Entrepreneurship. Admission under this category is open only to candidates who have already applied to AUD and whose names are not appearing in the second admission list of the course/s that they have applied for. However, candidates applying to PG Programme under CCA should have obtained the minimum eligibility scores in the written test and interview to be considered for admission.

They are required to apply on a specific CCA Application Form, downloadable from the AUD website, along with relevant certificates of achievement and portfolio, in any of categories for which CCA admissions are being considered this year. Hard copy of the application has to be submitted for the same to the Dean, Student Services, AUD. The shortlisted candidates will have to appear for trials/auditions in the concerned areas and fulfil a minimum standard as decided by the relevant trial/audition committee, after which eligible candidates will be recommended for admission to different programmes. The final decision to offer admission to candidates recommended by the CCA committee will be that of the Admission Committee of the particular programme/s that the candidate has applied to.

Candidates must attach copies of the following with the CCA form:

1. A letter of recommendation from the Principal/ officiating authority of the school/college last attended clearly giving details of activities participated in. The Principal should also express his/her opinion about the extent to which the candidate might be able to contribute to the cultural life of the University. While such a letter is not mandatory, it is desirable and will add weight to the application.
2. Documents in support of achievement in CCA on the basis of which admission is sought. The University is especially interested in the candidate's participation in school/college activities during the last three years.
3. Statement of Purpose written by the student stating how candidate will contribute to the life of the University and why the candidate has applied to AUD.
4. Portfolios are necessary for those applying under the category of Fine Arts/Painting/Sculpture/Photography/Film and desirable for all other categories.
5. A list of Co-Curricular Activities mentioning level of participation and prizes won in the last three years.
6. Those applying in the category of Performing Arts are required to submit a recording of their performances on a CD.
7. Mark-sheet on the basis of which admission is sought.



8. Date of Birth certificate or School examination certificate clearly stating the Date of Birth.

Important dates for BA applicants under CCA category

- 11 July 2015: Announce Shortlist of candidates for trials/auditions for BA programmes
- 14 July 2015: Trials/Auditions for CCA applicants to BA programmes
- 17 July 2015: Announce list of recommended candidates for BA programmes
- 18 and 20 July 2015: Payment of fees by candidates offered admission under CCA category for BA programmes

Important dates for MA applicants under CCA category

- 16-18 July 2015: Submit application under CCA category for all MA programmes
- 20 July 2015: Announce shortlist of candidates for trials/auditions for MA programmes
- 21 July 2015: Trials/Auditions for CCA applicants to MA programmes
- 23 July 2015: Announce list of recommended candidates for MA programmes
- 24-25 July 2015: Payment of fees by candidates offered admission under CCA category for MA programmes
