Special requirements of Various Schools of Studies

A. SCHOOLS

I. School of Design (SDes):

The School of Design focuses on design not only through formal and functional aspects which go into the design of objects, service systems and environments, but also through critical reflection on how design shapes society and environment and vice versa. In order to understand and leverage how design impacts social and cultural outcomes, the School of Design is re-imagining appropriate, inclusive and responsive design education for our present times. The School is currently offering 2&1/2 year fulltime Masters in Social Design is looking to recruit faculty mainly to strengthen the programme and initiate activities aligned with it.

The School is also envisaging new programmes at UG and PG levels in immediate future through ongoing consultative process and faculty participation.

- Issues of self-governance, equality, enterprise & resource access;

II. School of Education Studies (SES):

SES is envisioned to evolve as a community of professionals and scholars endeavoring to understand education in its historical and contemporary contexts through engaged scholarship and practice. The School proposes to bridge the gap between the theory and practice of education in its multiple locations – in that it would foster greater convergence between the study of education as a social phenomenon and the preparation of professional educators. The School is working towards development of a rigorous praxis-based theoretical perspective for analysis and research while engaging with teacher education, pedagogy, curriculum, policy planning and administration .
