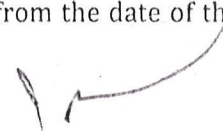

2. The Grievance Redressal Committee shall have the following Powers and Functions:

- a. It shall exercise its powers to hear any grievance –
 - i. of any student against the University or its constituent, as the case may be, after the student has availed of remedies available in such constituent for redressal of grievance; and
 - ii. of any applicant for admission as student to the University or its constituent.
- b. No application of re-evaluation of answer sheets shall be entertained by it unless specific irregularity materially affecting the outcome or specific instance of discrimination is indicated.
- c. It shall have power to seek the assistance of any person belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Socially and Economically Backward Classes, minority or disabled category, as amicus curiae, for hearing complaints of alleged discrimination.
- d. It shall communicate its decision within ten days of receipt of the complaint

3. The term of the members above shall be for a period of two years from the date of this notification.
