

FEE WAIVERS AND OTHER WELFARE MEASURES AT AUD

AUD has instituted the following measures for students to enhance equity and aid equal opportunity to the various educational, social and recreational activities and programmes at the university.

Fee Waiver

The University offers full and partial fee waivers to undergraduate and postgraduate students who are in need of support in relation to their socio-economic background. All students with family income less than 6 lakhs/annum will be considered for fee waiver from 25% waiver to 100 % waiver in proportion to their income. Full fee waiver is also extended to all students belonging to SC, ST and PwD categories (please keep your certificates ready for admissions).

Fee waivers may be applied for at the time of fee payment during the final stages of the admission process as per instructions issued then (income certificates are mandatory). For more information on fee waivers, refer to page-29-30 of the Bulletin of Admissions 2016.
