Ambedkar University Admissions 2021: The admissions to UG programmes will be merit-based and the varsity will release cut-offs.

Ambedkar University, Delhi has released an official notification inviting all the candidates for the undergraduate (UG) programme from July 12. The admissions to undergraduate programmes will be merit-based and the varsity will release cut-offs.

As per reports, the online registration process for postgraduate (PG) courses will begin from the end of July.

Further, Professor Anu Singh Lather, Vice-Chancellor, Ambedkar University Delhi (AUD) has announced that in the academic session 2021-22, the varsity will be launching six new programmes.

- 1. BA Hindi (Honours)
- 2. Masters of Public Health
- 3. M Voc Tourism and Hospitality Management
- 4. MA in Archaeology and Heritage Management (MAHM)
- 5. MA in Conservation, Preservation and Heritage Management (MCPHM)
- 6. Integrated MA-PhD (IPHD) in Human Ecology.

Amidst the public outcry over the Covid pandemic and the struggles of sustaining the public health system, the varsity launched a new programme in Masters in Public Health. The integrated MA-PHD(PhD) in Human Ecology is being started as per the New Education Policy, as reported by PTI.

Moreover, the varsity is all set to launch the four year BA (Hons) Political Science programme this year and share that consultations are also being held for other such programmes in accordance with the New Education Policy.

Admission to BA/MA/PhD programmes

Moreover, the varsity has also shortlisted 64 foreign students out of nearly 1,800 applications for admission for the BA/MA/PhD programmes through the ICCR process for the first time. Students from SAARC and African countries (Tanzania, Ghana, Malawi, South Sudan, Botswana, Somalia, Ethiopia, Zimbabwe; Zambia) have been shortlisted.

Total number of seats:

Further, the total UG and PG programmes and PhD on offer this year is 57. The number of PhD programmes will be updated soon.

Total seats on offer in undergraduate and postgraduate programmes will be 1,953, including seats in new programmes -- 44 in UG and 143 in PG.

Entrance exam:

As reported by PTI, the entrance exam for PG programmes is likely to be held in August if the Covid-19 situation normalises and exam centres are available and in accordance with the guidelines of the Delhi government, officials said, adding that in case the situation is not conducive, the varsity might opt for an online proctored exam.

Ambedkar University admissions 2021: UG registrations to begin from July 12, PG from end of July.

Admissions to undergraduate programmes will be merit-based, while postgraduate admissions will be based on entrance exams.

The total number of undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD programmes offered by Ambedkar University this year is 57.

Ambedkar University, Delhi on Monday released the admission brochure for undergraduate and postgraduate programmes for the academic year 2021-22. The registration process for undergraduate programmes will commence from July 12, while the postgraduate registrations will start at the end of July, said officials. The university also announced the launch of six new programmes.

The undergraduate admissions will be merit-based and the cut-offs for the same will be released when the CBSE and other boards release class 12 results. Entrance tests will be conducted for postgraduate admissions in August. However, the exams will only be conducted in offline mode if the Covid-19 situation allows for the same. If the situation is not conducive in August, the varsity may explore the option of online proctored examinations.

Professor Anu Singh Lather, Vice-Chancellor, Ambedkar University Delhi, stated that the total number of undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD programmes on offer this year is 57. The total number of seats on offer for undergraduate and postgraduate programmes for the year is 1,953.

The new programmes being offered by the varsity this year include BA Hindi (Honours), Masters of Public Health, M Voc Tourism and Hospitality Management, MA in Archaeology and Heritage Management (MAHM), MA in Conservation, Preservation and Heritage Management (MCPHM) and Integrated MA-PhD (IPHD) in Human Ecology.

The university has shortlisted 64 foreign students out of approximately 1,800 students for admissions to the BA/MA/Ph.D programmes through the ICCR process for the first time. Students from African and SAARC countries have been shortlisted.
