

All seven NCP MLAs in Nagaland join NDDP

KONIMA: All seven MLAs of the National Congress Party (NCP) in Nagaland joined the ruling National Democratic Progressive Party (NDPP) led by chief minister Neiphiu Rio on Saturday.

The merger gives the Rio-led NDPP an absolute majority in the 60-member assembly, increasing its tally from 25 to 32.

Following the development, state parliamentary affairs minister KG Kenye said the NCP MLAs submitted their letter for merger to the assembly speaker Shashikanth Longkumer on Saturday evening. The speaker has accepted their submission for merger to the NDPP party, Kenye said.

A statement from the speaker's office said that the merger met the constitutional requirement under the Tenth Schedule.

In line with the Members of Nagaland Legislative Assembly (Disqualification on Ground of Defection) Rules, 2019, the speaker approved the merger and directed the assembly secretariat to update party affiliation records accordingly, the order said.

The MLAs are Namri Nangri of Tening, Picto Shobe of Atotzu, Y. Mhonbemo Humtsao of Wokha Town, Y. Manikha Kon-yak of Mon Town, A. Fongshi Phom of Longleng, P. Long of Nohak, and S. Toho Yephso of Surubho.

NCP emerged as the third-largest party in the state in the 2023 assembly elections, after NDPP and its ally BJP, with 12 seats.

Govt to turn ESICs with 200+ beds into medical colleges: Mandaviya

NEW DELHI: Union labour minister Mansukh Mandaviya on Saturday said that the Centre would upgrade all hospitals of the Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) with 200 beds or more into full-fledged medical colleges as part of an ongoing expansion drive.

The government also proposes to reserve 40% of seats in these medical colleges for wards of employees with ESIC's health insurance cover, the minister said while inaugurating a 30-bed facility at Kala Amb in Himachal Pradesh. "40% of seats in these institutions will be reserved for the wards of insured persons, ensuring greater educational opportunities for workers' families," Mandaviya said.

The five-backed ESIC, which provides free, no-cash-celling healthcare to enrolled workers across the country, is in the process of setting up medical colleges in Mumbai's Andheri, Gurgaon, Madhya Pradesh's

Indore, Rajasthan's Jaipur, Punjab's Ludhiana, Gujarat's Narda-Bapunagar and Noida as well as Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh.

Set up under the Employees State Insurance Act 1948, ESIC covers all formal-sector workers with a monthly salary of ₹2,000 or less. It currently runs 165 hospitals nationwide, including medical colleges and a chain of 1,574 dispensaries, but these are not sufficient to cover workers in all districts of the country.

Under an expansion drive, the ESIC's coverage was recently extended to 15 additional districts, following which the organisation now covers 689 districts in the country, of which 586 are fully operational. IFF had signed an April 1.

The National Monuments Authority (NMA), a statutory body under the Ministry of Culture, constituted under the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1956 (as amended in 2010), invites applications from the eminent professionals with proven experience and expertise in the fields of Archaeology, Country and Town Planning, Architecture, Heritage, Conservation- Architecture or Law for appointment as Part-Time Members (05) of the National Monuments Authority (NMA).

 - iv. Any person, who had either been granted a permission or license or refused any such permission or refused grant of a license or any person or any of his/her relative having any interest in a prohibited area or a regulated area shall not be eligible to be appointed as a Part-Time Member. For the purpose, "relative" means:
 - a. Spouse of the Chairperson or Member of the NMA;
 - b. Brother or sister of the Chairperson or Member of the NMA;
 - c. Brother or sister of the spouse of the Chairperson or Member of the NMA;
 - d. Brother or sister of either of the parents of the Chairperson or Member of the NMA;
 - e. Any lineal ascendant or descendant of the Chairperson or Member of the NMA;
 - f. Any lineal ascendant or descendant of the spouse of the Chairperson or Member of the NMA;
 - g. Spouse of the person referred to in clauses (b) to (f).
 - v. The Part-Time Member shall be eligible for sitting allowance of Rs. 5,000/- (Rs. five thousand) for each meeting day, he/she attends the meeting of the Authority but not exceeding Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty thousand) in a month and shall be entitled to reimbursement of transportation charges at the rates as admissible to the Whole-Time Member of the NMA.
