The Central Air Quality Monitoring (CAQM) system, which is a part of the National Air Quality Index (AQI) system, is a key tool for monitoring and managing air quality in Delhi-NCR. The system is designed to provide real-time data on air quality, which can be used to inform policy decisions and to take action to improve air quality. The CAQM system is a complex system that involves a network of sensors and a central database. The sensors are located at various locations in Delhi-NCR, and they collect data on various pollutants, including particulate matter, nitrogen dioxide, and sulfur dioxide. The data is then sent to a central database, where it is processed and analyzed. The results of the analysis are then used to generate reports and to inform policy decisions.
