While a comparatist or translator must have close-reading skills in the original language, researchers may also choose to bring literary studies in dialogue with other disciplines from the humanities. The programme encourages the practice of translation and recognizes that it promotes the reading and dissemination of literatures in as many languages as possible, with a focus on Indian and literary languages from southern Asia.
