#### From the Desk of the Vice Chancellor

It gives me immense pleasure to share with all of you the University Newsletter 2023 (combined 8 and 9), special issue on G 20 activities. The terms of reference of G 20, VasudhaivaKutumbakam 'One Earth, One Family, One Future' with India hosting the G 20 summit, were the driving philosophy behind most of our events from January to September 2023. The University responded to this commitment by notifying a G 20 Nodal Officer and a team of core members to organize, coordinate and report on the government portals on a timely manner on all the activities.

University organized programmes under G 20 Working groups themes on Culture, Digital Economy, Education, Environment and Climate Sustainability and Tourism. There were a number of youth based programmes, both involving students of our University as well as from outside under the Youth 20 engagement group that G 20 facilitates. The main objective to organize various events in connection to G 20 themes were: a) to make more students familiarize with the goals and objectives of G20 and India's role in it and b) to mark our commitment as a University towards initiatives of national importance.

I want to specially mention the students and faculty of B. Voc and M. Voc Tourism and Hospitality Studies, from the School of Vocational Studies who used their in-house Training Kitchen at our Karampura campus and held food festivals of diverse G 20 countries. We were delighted to have the Brazilian first ambassador in one such event, showcasing the country's cuisine.

There were various outreach initiatives in which our students participated—being part of Hon'ble LG's inspection visit to Qudsia Ghat was one, sending relief materials to flood affected homes near

the Kashmere Gate campus or field trip to AadiMahotsav.

There were many competitions organized to both spread awareness as well as instill patriotism in the minds of college going youth through photography competition on Delhi: A Heritage City or *nukkadnatak* competition on Ambedkar and his Struggle for Community Upliftment or Hackathon on Environment and Climate Sustainability.

The third *Shodotsav* University Research Festival was also organized keeping the spirit of G 20 themes alive. There was a G 20 Research Scholars Conclave titled Knowledge Exchange in a Globalised World and a National Conference for Young Scholars on Understanding the Social World: Theories, Methods and Practices. On the occasion of Teachers Day the University organized the Second Research Awards ceremony. Chairman, EC NAAC Prof. Anil Sahasrabudhe was the Chief Guest. 22 faculty members of the University received awards in different categories of the AURPIS Scheme, for publishing research in reputed journals. In addition, 12 Ph.D Scholars received the Merit Scholarships in the second round.

Having conducted various initiatives under the aegis of G20 towards the end of the year the University is firmly resolving its pledge to Sustainable Development Goals and has organized programmes around climate change, education equality, and heritage inclusive cities.

As a public university in Delhi, we realize the tremendous opportunity we have and with our students, faculty and staff we have successfully engaged with G 20 objectives, making it a participatory citizen driven initiative.



#### Letter from the Editor

This is the first time that the AUD Newsletter is focusing on a Special Issue—G 20 activities of the University, held from January to September 2023. Various programmes under the different themes of G 20 were carried out within the University involving active participation of students and faculty. Various inter-university competitions were also organized, on theatre, photography, quiz which created a vibrant campus life.

The highlight of the G 20 activities was the Food Festivals of Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Indonesia and Germany, organized by the students and faculty of B.Voc and M.Voc Tourism and Hospitality programmes. On some of these food festivals, the International Affairs Division collaborated giving a brief overview of the culture, society and cuisine of the G 20 country in question. A lot of curiosity and enthusiasm was witnessed among the students.

The University organized two National Young Scholars conferences in 2023. The first by Research and

The second was a Research Scholars National Seminar on 'Heritage Changes: Creating a Resilient Agenda' organized by the School of Heritage Research and Management on November 28. Both the events saw keen participation from young and early career research scholars from across the country.

The University is ending the year with its commitment towards UN Sustainable Development Goals and Viksit Bharat@2047 initiatives.

#### Prof Satyaketu Sankrit, Nodal Officer G 20

In the dynamic realm of academia and cultural engagement, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University Delhi, under the leadership and guidance of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Anu Singh Lather, has made an enduring impact through a series of impactful G20 activities held during India's Presidency in 2023. Commencing with World Hindi Day on January 10th and continuing through the Independence Day celebrations, the university has consistently served as a symbol of academic excellence, cultural vibrancy, and collaborative initiatives.

The World Hindi Day was celebrated with a thought-provoking lecture by Dr. B.L. Gaur titled 'Hindi Ki Vishwa Yatra', setting the stage for a series of intellectually stimulating events. Two days later, on National Youth Day, the focus shifted to the dynamism and potential of the younger generation, a recurring theme in various activities throughout the year.



International Education Day on January 24th marked a celebration of global learning, reflecting the university's commitment to fostering international collaborations. The subsequent day featured a Panel Discussion on 'Promoting Entrepreneurship in Higher Education Institutions,' emphasizing the significance of cultivating an entrepreneurial spirit among students.

On January 26th, the G20 Walk and a simultaneous Sports Event commemorated Republic Day, underscoring the importance of physical well-being and the spirit of sportsmanship. The month concluded with an International Seminar on 'Bhartiya Chintan aur G20,' providing a platform to explore India's philosophical contributions in the G20 context.

February witnessed a diverse array of activities, from the Flag March on the 6th to the G20 Model Working Group Meeting on Digital Economy Initiatives. The Argentina Cuisine Food Festival on February 10th, along with subsequent events like the Inter-University Ideathon competition and the Cyber Security Awareness Programme, highlighted the university's commitment to cross-cultural experiences and digital literacy.

March featured significant events, including the LIFE Workshop on Sustainable and Ethical Travel on March 1st, exemplifying the university's dedication to promoting sustainability across various domains. The G20 Hackathon, launched on the 17th, reinforced the importance of technological innovation and creative problem-solving. The French Food Festival, Lecture & Live Art Demonstration, and Case Study Challenge continued to showcase the rich cultural tapestry and intellectual prowess of the university community.

The Panel Discussion, Painting Competition, Street Play Competition, and the 13th Ambedkar Memorial Lecture in the month of April were instrumental in creating platforms for intellectual discourse, artistic expression, and engaging performances. May brought forth a series of academic and skill-building activities, from the first session of the CESIM Simulation on May 1st to the Workshop on Case Writing on May 2nd and the G20 Research Methodology Workshop on Labour Studies from May 10th to May 12th. The School of Heritage, Research Management celebrated International Museum Day by visiting the Pradhanmantri Sanghralaya on May 17th, showcasing the university's engagement with cultural heritage. The latter half of the year featured diverse events, including an Industrial Trip to Parle G on May 22nd, a Jan Bhagidari-Webinar on the Future of Work, and the G20 Shodhotsav, an Annual research festival of the University organized by the Research and Development Division. The Meri Maati Mera Desh campaign, encompassing tree plantation drives and a pottery workshop, underscored the university's commitment to environmental sustainability.

As the year unfolded, G20 activities became a testament to the university's dedication to holistic education, global collaboration, and cultural exchange. The seamless integration of academic forums, cultural celebrations, and skill-building initiatives has not only enriched the university experience but also contributed significantly to India's presidency of the G20 in 2023. Through these endeavors, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University Delhi has not only embraced the spirit of the G20 but has also emerged as a model for educational institutions aspiring to foster excellence, inclusivity, and global citizenship.
