'Stay Safe Online', 'Online Suraksha Kavach' is one of the first programs to be launched as part of G 20 initiatives by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Government of India. The objective of the 'Stay Safe Online campaign' is to raise awareness among citizens to stay safe in the online world due to the widespread use of social media platforms and rapid adoption of digital payments. Keeping in line with the mandate of this just launched campaign, the Outreach and Extension Division of Dr B R Ambedkar University Delhi, conducted a Cyber Security Awareness Programme on Sunday Feb 12, 2023 at the Chhat Park, Jawahar Camp, Kirti Nagar which falls under the site of the adopted villages of the university. Dr B R Ambedkar University Delhi currently has three adopted villages of Jawahar camp, Chuna Bhatti, Kirti Nagar 5/25. The mission of the programme was to make citizens of all age groups, especially children, students, senior citizens, in these villages, aware of cyber risks and ways to deal with it. The awareness programme today was carried out in Hindi with a presentation from the university team of Dr. Dinesh Taneja (Director, IT) and Shri Santulan Chaubey, Joint Director with Delhi Government and Research Scholar, SBPPSE. Special comments on real cyber risk situations and ways to avoid them were provided by Shri Vikender Gulia, HC, Cyber Police, West Delhi Police.

The awareness programme included staging of two Plays by the students of the School of Business, Public Policy and Social Entrepreneurship of the university. Dissemination print material was shared with the members of the community as part of the event. This is the beginning of the series of programmes on cyber security awareness that the University is aiming to conduct both for the entire student and faculty community of the university and for other citizens of Delhi.
