Brief Description of the Activity:

SARAS, 'Sale of Articles of Rural Artisans Society', which is an attempt to showcase diverse culture, forest produce, handlooms, and handicrafts, and rural, particularly women entrepreneurship, contribution of self-help groups to economic development of the country. SARAS activities throughout the country strengthen and promote cultural and knowledge exchanges while also showcasing to the country rural expertise, talents, and entrepreneurial acumen of artists, farmers, SHGs, weavers, and other crafts persons.
