Abstract: The Organisation for Early Literacy Promotion or OELP began as an exploratory search in 2006. Our idea was to engage with children within and outside classrooms to understand some natural ways in which children learn. We wanted to explore ways in which these can be facilitated inside classrooms so that all children can learn with fullness and actualize their potentials. Our programmes and innovations aim to go beyond the concerns of access and outcomes to concerns which lay emphasis on what educational experiences mean for each child's identity, self worth and learning. OELP views itself as a search for meaningful and innovative and doable classroom practice which can enhance the quality of learning for each child during the early foundation building years of early childhood. Our programmes and innovations are evolving organically through our sustained and intensive engagement with learners and learning contexts as well as through engagement with insights from research based literature. This journey in which we have been involved over the past ten years still continues.
