Admission process for Academic Year 2022-23 for Undergraduate programmes of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi

Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University Delhi, a State University established by the Government of NCT of Delhi requests applicants seeking admission to various Undergraduate programmes under different Schools of Studies in Kashmere Gate campus and Karampura campus for the Academic year 2022-23. The admission process has started for Academic Year 2022-23 for Undergraduate programmes of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi. Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi has joined the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) to be conducted by NTA. The CUET will provide a single window opportunity to students to seek admission. In this regard, the National Testing Agency has been entrusted with the responsibility of conducting the Undergraduate entrance tests for the academic session 2022-23.

All candidates who are willing to study at Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi have to register for Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG) 2022] at cuet.samarth.ac.in before 22.05.2022 (5 PM).

(Relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwBD/Delhi-OBC(NCL)/Defence/Kashmiri Migrant). Merit will be calculated by considering the CUET SCORE obtained in the mentioned combination of subjects.
17	BACHELOR OF ARTS (HONOURS) MATHEMATICS	Section II: Mathematics and Best of any three other subjects either from Section II or Section IA	Candidates must appear in CUET. Applicants need to have passed the class XII examination with at least 50% marks from CBSE/DBSE or any recognised Board with at least 65% marks in Mathematics. (Relaxation of 5% marks for SC/ST/PwBD/Delhi-OBC(NCL)/Defence/Kashmiri Migrant). Merit will be calculated by considering the CUET SCORE obtained in the mentioned combination of subjects.

Applicants shall be admitted to Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University Delhi on the basis of eligibility criterion detailed above in the table against each programme.

Applicants seeking admission has to apply separately at www.aud.ac.in for various programmes offered by Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi. For updates related to application, applicants are advised to visit University (www.aud.ac.in) and NTA (nta.ac.in)/CUET (cuet.samarth.ac.in) website regularly.
