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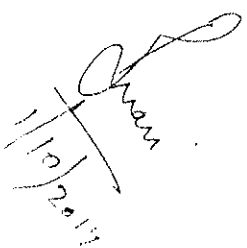

**Finalisation of SLS Scholarship Awards for Monsoon Semester 2014 (WS
2014)**

1. The Scholarship Committee noted the AUD guidelines for scholarship awards and the amounts available for each MA programme as per notesheet sent by Assistant Registrar, Student Services (copy attached). The scholarships can be given to the top 20% of the batch purely on the basis of merit. In addition to this, a maximum of two scholarships per programme can be given to students as a reward for improvement if they have improved their overall GPA by at least two grades. The scholarship amounts can range between Rs 5000 and Rs 8000. It was noted that batch-wise caps lead to underutilisation of scholarship awards in some batches and deficits in other batches within a programme. The same is true for different programmes within a school. It was decided that the total amounts available for scholarship would be pooled across batches for a particular programme. Also, any surplus in a particular programme would be used to compensate for deficit in any other programme in SLS.
2. The Committee accepted the Economics Faculty's additional criterion of achievement of a minimum grade of B in all courses in

the semester for eligibility of the scholarship in the Economics programme.

3. The Committee discussed the guideline of award of 10% of the total fees to only 20% of a cohort. A cap of Rs 8000 as the maximum amount of scholarship had been fixed by the University keeping in mind Rs. 16000 per semester as fee. This allows the programme to distribute 10% of the collected fees to 20% of the students. Therefore given that the fee has been now raised to Rs 20,000 per semester, either the cap on the maximum should be increased to Rs. 10000, or 10% of the fees should be distributed among the top 25% of the students. Without these changes, 10% of the fees cannot be fully utilized as scholarship. The members unanimously recommended that the University should change the guidelines for scholarship awards to top 25% of the students for full utilization of scholarship awards.
4. Till the time that the University guidelines are not revised, the Committee agreed to base the awards for Monsoon Semester 2014 on the existing guidelines.
5. The Committee also considered the case of the students (brought to the notice of the Committee by Sanjay K Sharma and Shiv Kumar) who had been wrongfully excluded from the list of awardees for Winter Semester 2014 due to mistakes in the student lists generated by the School office from ERP. Given that
 - a. there have been unutilised balances from previous semesters, and
 - b. keeping in mind the fee hike, which has also generated a surplus (because the cap of 20% of students for scholarship awards has not been revised), and
 - c. the mistake was due to wrong student lists provided by the School office,

the members unanimously agreed that the wrongful exclusions should be corrected. Accordingly, the Committee recommends that the following students should be awarded scholarships for the Winter Semester 2014 according to the table given below:
