General Instructions: All candidates must report at 4 pm at Admission Information and Facilitation Desk, just near the University Main Gate, Kashmere Gate Campus along with the following documents:

- A copy of their AUD Admission Form,
- A Photo ID, such as Aadhar Card,
- The original certificates with self-attested photocopies in support of the application for admission under CCA quota. The performance trials will not be evaluated for the applicants without the original certificates.

Specific Instructions for CCA categories:

1. Fine Arts:

• Candidates MUST carry a maximum of his/her best three piece of art work.

2. Literary Art:

- The candidates must carry a blue/black pen.
- Mobile phones and other electronic items are strictly prohibited inside the exam
- The trials will include: performance trial (written), interview, and verification of certificates and other evidence of literary work.

3. Quiz:

- The trial for the quiz society will consist of a multiple-choice question (MCQ) based exam of 50 marks. The candidates will be examined on their general awareness.
- The exam will be of 1 hour duration from 4 PM to 5 PM. The entry to the exam hall requires a valid photo identity card and the candidates must report to the invigilators latest by 3.45 PM, after which no one will be allowed to enter the exam hall.
- The candidates must carry a blue/black ball pen for the exam.
- Mobile phones and other electronic items are strictly prohibited inside the exam hall.

4. Dance:

- Candidates must carry their audio pieces
- Candidates must be dressed in their dance costumes. No time shall be given for changing costumes before the trial.
- The performances should not be less than 5 minutes.
- 5. Theatre: Theatre/Performance Trials will have two components:

- a. Performance (5 Minutes): Each Candidate should prepare a solo performance to demonstrate theatre skills.
- b. Interview and interaction with the panel (5 minutes).

6. Music:

- Candidates must carry their audio pieces
- Candidates must bring musical instrument to be used.
- The performances should not be less than 5 minutes.

7. Fashion:

- Candidates must carry their video pieces
- Candidates must be dressed in their dance costumes. No time shall be given for changing costumes before the trial.
- The performances should not be less than 5 minutes.

8. Debating:

• The trials will include: performance trial, interview, and verification of certificates.

9. Visual Culture:

- Candidates MUST carry a maximum of his/her best three piece of visual cultural work (photographs, films).
- Performance trial will be on the sites of KG campus.
